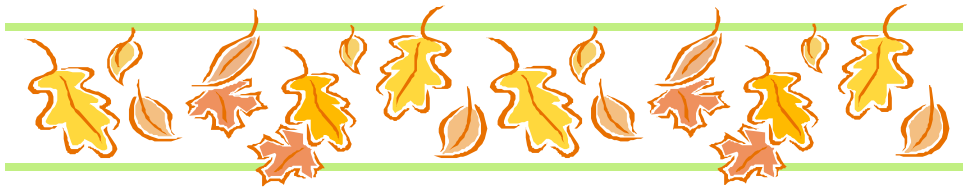

Biography

Caroline Marshall is an Associate Principal with ENVision – the Hough Group, a long-standing landscape architecture and environmental planning firm located in Toronto. Over her eighteen years of practice, she has focused on public sector projects including subwatershed studies, municipal secondary plans for urbanizing areas, parks and recreation master plans, trails planning, and large-scale park master planning projects. In response to changes in provincial policy, Ms. Marshall has recently been engaged in the assessment of cultural heritage landscapes, and has worked closely with archaeologists, planners, built heritage specialists, and biologists on studies that have both established criteria for identifying cultural heritage landscapes, and recommended planning tools for their conservation.

Synopsis

*Most of the natural areas around us have been modified by people over long periods of time, and there is an intrinsic relationship between the cultural and natural worlds. The concept of **cultural heritage landscapes (CHLs)** investigates this human interaction with the natural environment, and the manner in which it has influenced the settlement patterns, structures and traditions of a community. Although policies pertaining to cultural heritage landscapes are rooted in heritage resource protection, this presentation will discuss how the conservation of CHLs is also being used to contribute to environmental protection and stewardship, using examples from other Ontario municipalities.*
